

2020 Fiscal Year Report


Total Revenue and Support

Operating Revenue by Program


Total Operating Revenue: \$10,252,658

2020 Impact on Rhode Island



30 families in our Family Care Community Partnership (FCCP) have found permanent housing while in the program.

6,000 Rhode Islanders benefited from one or more Child & Family programs and services.



480 seniors secured health insurance coverage by working with Child & Family Medicare/Medicaid experts.



More than 64 foster children were successfully placed with loving and supportive foster families.



271 families across RI were helped through our Family Preservation programs.

974 seniors received services through Child & Family, including case management, counseling, and basic needs assistance.



Over 132 students enrolled at Sandpipers Early Learning Center.

9 homeless families were provided with a safe and nurturing place to live through our Supportive Housing program.
