Child & Family's commitment to our community has been strong and unwavering since we began serving Newport County and Rhode Island in 1866. Our core values that led us this far will carry us through to brighter days, especially now, as our services are more valuable than ever. Child & Family has developed various programs to support all in need, regardless of age or situation. We provide early childhood development education and care, housing for women and children, foster care services, counseling for seniors in times of struggle, and family therapy. Our devotion to helping the most vulnerable populations binds us together and creates an important sense of solidarity during these difficult times.

OUR WORK in 2022



Over **6,000** Rhode Islanders benefited from one or more Child & Family programs and/or services.



72 children were successfully placed with loving and supportive foster families.



1,200 older adults received case management support and services through our various Aging Well programs.



208 families across Rhode Island were helped through our Family Preservation programs.



44 foster youth met their permanency goals.



186 families received services through our Wraparound Treatment Model.



We cared for clients ranging in age from **newborn to 101 years old**.

CHILD & FAMILY PROGRAMS

- **Supportive Housing for Homeless Families:** Child & Family's Supportive Housing program is a transitional living program located in Newport that provides homeless parents and their children with a safe, secure, and therapeutic community in which they live for up to 24 months. Residents work with staff to gain parenting strategies, employment, educational opportunities, and enhanced life skills, as staff assist them to secure permanent housing.
- **Semi-Independent Living Program:** Often foster care is not an option for the youth in our Semi-Independent Living Program, and our experienced staff has the tremendous responsibility of helping these teenagers through the complex traumas they have endured. We endeavor to create a sense of "normalcy" by providing therapeutic support in a home-like and nurturing environment while assisting the adolescents in their educational and vocational goals to transition to an independent living setting.
- **Independent Living Program:** Child & Family's "Bridge to Success" Independent Living Program provides support for youth who are aging out of the child welfare system. By providing secure housing, employment counseling, life skills training, and other supports, the program will help ensure a smoother transition to adulthood for these vulnerable 17-to-20-year-olds.
- **Foster Care:** Child & Family recognizes that many youth in foster care have emotional and behavioral challenges related to loss and trauma. For over 30 years, Child & Family's Foster Care programs have provided therapeutic support to vulnerable youth in a consistent, supportive family setting, crucial to their success, with the goal of eventual reunification with their parents. **We are always looking for new foster families who will open up their hearts and homes. - **Family Care Community Partnership (FCCP):** By bringing families together with natural and community supports, the FCCP helps families rediscover a sense of hope for their family and provides the tools needed to foster a stronger, brighter future.
- **Family Stabilization Program (FSP):** FSP utilizes a family-systems model in providing family therapy and case management support. This program assists families in identifying strengths to make the changes they need to create permanent family relationships and lead safe and healthy lives.
- **Functional Family Therapy (FFT):** FFT is an intensive, short-term family therapy and intervention program for youth and their families. FFT focuses on the family's relational styles to help build positive interactions within the family and community.
- **Family Centered Treatment (FCT):** The FCT model is an evidence-based family therapy program that provides intensive support for at-risk families.
- **Case Management for Aging Well Clients:** As Rhode Island's older resident population grows, Child & Family's Aging Well Program seeks to enhance their quality of life with dignity and respect for independence. Serving thousands of older Rhode Islanders each year, our goal is to help our older Rhode Island neighbors remain safely in their homes and provide other critical services, such as Medicare and Medicaid Enrollment Counseling information regarding health insurance eligibility and benefits.
- **Sandpipers Early Learning Center:** At Sandpipers Early Learning Center, a year-round, full-time childcare facility, Child & Family is committed to providing the highest quality developmental care and educational experiences for children aged six weeks to five years. The Center annually serves up to 150 children at 31 John Clarke Road in Middletown.

Missions Align to Help Families

Child & Family held its 8th annual "Townsend Luncheon" on June 22 at OceanCliff Hotel & Resort. Thanks to community partners, as well as an exciting "Fund the Mission," the luncheon raised more than \$75,000 to benefit Child & Family programs.

The event is a celebration of Ellen Townsend and her founding of Child & Family, originally an orphanage, in 1866. "My children and I were given a sanctuary thanks to the amazing Supportive Housing program," said the keynote speaker, Collete Rinkel. "Without the support of Child & Family, my babies and I would not have a home, [and] we wouldn't be finding time to thrive and make the strides we have."

Through the Supportive Housing program, parents are provided with wraparound case-management services and the resources necessary to secure permanent housing and improve the overall wellbeing of their families. Up to 12 families each year directly benefit from the program, which is 100 percent philanthropy-funded through community partners like Mark and Ida Aramli, owners of BedJet and founders of The Aramli Foundation, who donated \$25,000 to Fund the Mission.

"Our foundation's mission is most heavily focused on vulnerable children and families in the area surrounding BedJet headquarters in Newport," Mark Aramli said. "When we were researching non-profits that support families throughout Newport County, it was obvious the mission of Child & Family aligns with our own, and we are thrilled to co-chair their 39th annual 'Taste of Newport.'"

Child & Family will return to an in-person Taste of Newport on Oct. 23. As in years past, guests will enjoy a variety of small plates and tasting stations, presented by the finest restaurants, caterers, beverage vendors and confectioners. To learn more, visit childandfamilyri.com.

The annual fundraiser benefits the many Rhode Island families, children and older adults who use Child & Family programs and services during times of crisis.

One of the key programs is Supportive Housing for Mothers, which provides housing for up to two years and helps mothers develop life skills and parenting strategies.

Another well-known program is the Foster Parent program for children and teens in which foster families receive comprehensive training before and during their time of providing care.

In addition, the elder care initiative provides assistance to enhance the quality of life in order to live independently.

At this time of year, Child & Family will be focusing its giving efforts on the December holidays, collecting toys, gifts and clothing for children in need as part of the Adopt-A-Family Holiday Program. People can get specific wish lists to fulfill or choose to purchase generic toys and gifts that will be distributed to clients in need. Donation drop-off dates are Dec. 6-7.
